

Parking in Station Road – a step closer to success.

As some of you will remember Dr Leary has been trying to improve the parking situation outside the surgery for both patients of the surgery and local shoppers before 9.30am. Presently you are not allowed to park until after 9.30am.

Dr. Leary raised a petition with more than 600 signatures. This was presented by Dr. Leary to the council in September.

We are very pleased to be able to report that the council have considered the changes and have agreed **“the recommendations are progressed”**. The council’s conclusions are summarised below. The next stage is that the proposed changes are advertised and there is then an opportunity for people to write in to either support or object to the proposals. We feel the councils proposed changes are an improvement on the original proposals because they also reduce the risk of the road being blocked by cars parked on each side, preventing larger vehicles passing through.

ANNEX A: Parking in Hinchley Wood Station Approach

Proposed Change: Between Nos. 1 & 5 install limited waiting parking bays at each end of existing disabled bay to accommodate approximately two cars each (11m) - 'Mon - Fri 8.30 -18.30 for 30 minutes only, no return within 1 hour'. On opposite side convert single yellow line to double yellow line for length of new bays.

Reason: Install six limited waiting parking bays between nos. 1 and 7 to allow limited parking for patients attending Lantern surgery – from 08.30 onwards.

Action: Advertise

8 CONCLUSION AND REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS

8.1 It is recommended that the locations requiring parking controls and identified in **Annex A**, be progressed so that the current parking difficulties highlighted within the borough can be resolved. The main reasons are as follows:-

- to improve road safety
- to assist with access for emergency vehicles
- to aid access for refuse vehicles
- to ease congestion and improve the environment for residents
- to improve parking facilities for the disabled

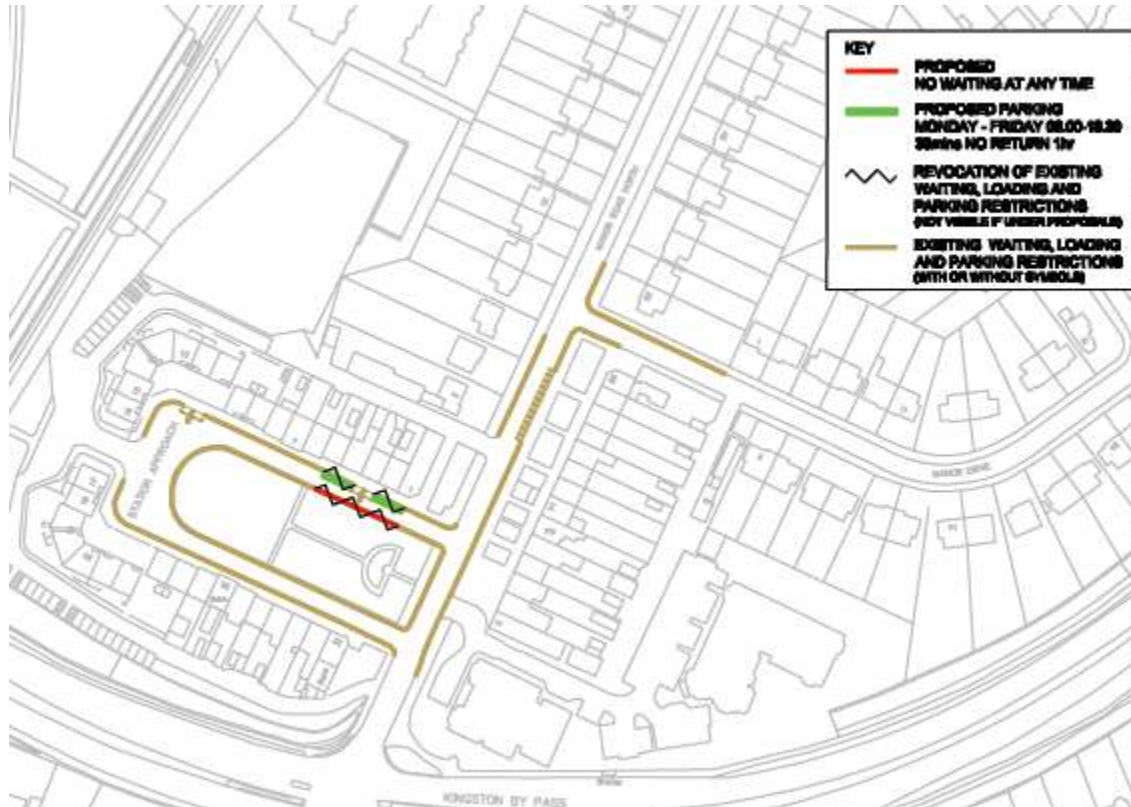
9 WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

9.1 Further consultation takes place in selected locations.

9.2 The agreed amendments to the existing parking controls are advertised in accordance with the statutory process.

9.3 Subject to sufficient funding being available in 2012/13 a new traffic regulation order will be made and amendments made to the existing traffic regulation orders, and the agreed new parking controls will be introduced.
